***APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT**

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Warren M. Kendall (Name of applicant)
of Nehalem (Postoffice), County of Clatsop,
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the
following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Unnamed stream, tributary of North Fork Nehalem River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic and irrigation of domestic garden not exceeding 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 12, 1936

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Sept. 10, 1937 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1938

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1939
