

**\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT**

**To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon**

I, F. F. Hibbard (Name of applicant)  
of Kerby (Postoffice), County of Josephine,  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring (Name of stream)  
a tributary of Illinois River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1  
cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and 1 ac. garden  
(Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 252 ft. S and 140 ft. W from the NW  
corner of D.C. #43 in Section 23, T. 40 S., R. 8 W.W.M.

R. 8 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

**DIVERSION WORKS—**

6. (a) Height of dam 1 feet, length on top 3 feet, length at bottom  
3 feet; material to be used and character of construction

Box sump. Wasteway over  
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Timber. One opening. 0.5' x 1.0'  
(Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description  
(Size and type of pump)

(Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding 1 acre in area

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 3, 1936

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 15, 1937 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1938

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1939
