

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Charles S. Hall and William Bartels of Cottage Grove, Oregon, County of Lane, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation no

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed spring, a tributary of Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.05 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 930 ft. N and 2450 ft. E from the Sec. corner of Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24, in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 22 S., R. 10 W.W.M.

being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 22 S, R. 10 W, W. M., in the county of Douglas

5. The pipe line to be 830 feet in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 22 S, R. 10 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Unnamed spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 3, 1936

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 15, 1937 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1938

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1939
