This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use measured at the point of diversion from the stream, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic feet per second/or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed spring branch

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation and stock

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 3, 1936

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 3, 1938 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1938
