

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 12346

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

Luvila S., Inc., an Oregon corporation, of Tuffs Building, Grants Pass, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Stratton Creek, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.38 cubic feet per second. for irrigation and one second foot for mining.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation and mining.

4. The point of diversion is located 900 ft. S and 800 ft. W from the NE corner of section 5, T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

being within the NE 1/4 of Sec. 5, Tp. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The ditch to be 1/2 mile in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 5, Tp. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. (a) Height of dam 3 feet, length on top 20 feet, length at bottom 20 feet; material to be used and character of construction Timber crib.

(b) Description of headgate Timber. One opening. 1' x 1'

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.38 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Stratton Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation and mining, being 0.38 c.f.s. for irrigation and 1.0 c.f.s. for mining

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 22, 1936

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 8, 1938 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1938

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1939
