*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, O. L. Richardson, of Rogue River, County of Jackson State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Private Spring, Rogue River watershed, a tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic and garden.

4. The point of diversion is located 850 ft. North and 1350 ft. East from the Southwest corner of Section 16,

being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The pipe line to be 1100 feet in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A Spring, Rogue River Watershed

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding 2 acres in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 25, 1937

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 27, 1938 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1939

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1940
