To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Incorporated July 10, 1936 at Bend, Oregon

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Pole Creek Swamp Springs and old channel of Pole Creek, a tributary of Squaw Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.50 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Municipal supply for the Town of Sisters, Oregon.

4. The point of diversion are located 500 ft. N. and 560 ft. E. from the corner of Section 35 (approximately) and bearings are shown on accompanying map to exact location of springs. Bearings are also given on Pick up ditch from springs to Pole Creek Ditch.

being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 15 S., R. 9 E., W. M., in the county of Deschutes

5. The Pipe Line to be 10,000 feet in length, terminating in the of Sec. 4 & 9, Tp. 15, R. 10 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS— Small ditch 2 feet wide leads from springs to Pole Creek Ditch.

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

Water to be diverted from Pole Creek ditch to pipe line in Section 19, Township 15 S., Range 10 E. as shown on general map.

(b) Description of headgate No headgate needed. Concrete or wooden gate, weir and overflow back into Pole Creek will be installed.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Pole Creek Swamp Springs, tributary of Squaw Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is

Domestic and Municipal Supply

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 7, 1937.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 11, 1938 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1939

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1940.
