

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Rogue River National Forest (Name of applicant) of Medford, Oregon (Postoffice), County of Jackson State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is A spring tributary to Stewart Creek, a tributary of Wall Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 300 gallon storage tank on line cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and garden (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and ft. from the corner of

1325 feet south, 77 degrees west from the east 1/4 section corner of section 24, Township 32 South, range 2 W., W. M.

being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 32 S., R. 2 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The Pipe line to be Approx. 2600 feet. in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 32 S., R. 1 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Spring, trib.

Stewart Creek, tributary Wall Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic and Garden not exceeding 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 27, 1937

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 29, 1938 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1939

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1940
