To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

Y, We, Judge H. J. Bean and P. L. Frazier, (755 & 745 N. Capitol St., respectively,) of Salem, Oregon, County of Marion, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mill Creek, a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second.

Beginning at a point on the West line of Capitol Street where said West line intersects the South line of the alley running Easterly and Westerly along the North line of P. L. Frazier's land; said beginning point being 167 feet South of the South line of Parrish Street; and running thence Southerly along said West line of Capitol Street, 43 feet; thence Westerly parallel with said alley, 150 feet; thence Northerly, parallel with Capitol Street, 43 feet; thence Easterly along the South line of said alley, 150 feet to the place of beginning; being situated in the City of Salem, in Marion County, State of Oregon, in the Donation Land Claim of Josiah L. Parrish and wife, in Township 7 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon.

Beginning at a point on the West line of Capitol Street, which point is 210 feet South of the South line of Parrish Street; thence running Southerly along the West line of Capitol Street, 26 feet; thence Westerly parallel with the South line of Parrish Street, 150 feet; thence Northerly parallel with Capitol Street, 26 feet; thence Easterly parallel with Parrish Street, 150 feet, to the place of beginning; being situated in the City of Salem, in the Donation Land Claim of Josiah L. Parrish and wife, in Township 7 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Mill Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 7, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 20, 1939 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1941
