*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Beatrice E. Galbreath (Name of applicant) of Eagle Point (Postoffice), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Little Butte Creek and return waters (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.02 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Garden Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 500 ft. North and 1425 ft. West from the E 1/4 corner of Section 3, (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction sump in solid rock (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Little Butte Creek and Return Waters

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 12, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 20, 1939 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1941
