\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Alpha Reese (Name of applicant) of Freewater (Postoffice), County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Waste water from NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sect. 34 T. 6 N. R. 35 E., a tributary of None

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.67 cubic feet per second. #1 - 0.34 #2 - 0.33

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located #1 8 E and #2 330 E from the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sect. 34 T. 6 N. R. 35 E. W. M.

being within the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M., in the county of Umatilla

5. The 660 ft in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Waste Water from N 1/2 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 34, T. 6 N. R. 35 E., W.M., being 0.188 c.f.s. from #1 and 0.187 c.f.s. from #2.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 14, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 28, 1939 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1941
