*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, A. A. Schramm (Name of applicant) of Corvallis (Postoffice), County of Benton State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Creek and Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Little North Fork of the North Fork of Santiam River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. Size of intake 4 inches reduced to 3 with further reduction to 1 inch.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic purposes and for the irrigation of a garden not exceeding 1/2 acre in area.

4. The point of diversion is located 200 ft. South and 900 ft. East from the NW corner of Sec. 14, T. 9 S., R. 2 E.,

being within the of Sec. of Tp. R. W. M., in the county of Marion

5. The pipeline to be in Sec. 14 and Sec. 11 to be approx. 630 ft. long in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 11, Tp. 9 S. R. 2 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Creek and Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic, including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding 1/2 acre in area.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 10, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 28, 1939 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1941
