

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 14632

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ida J. Wing of O'Brien, County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rough & Ready Creek, a tributary of Illinois River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.80 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 2000 ft. N. and 700 ft. W. from the So. 1/4 corner of Section 14, T. 40 S., R. 9 W., W.M.

being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 14, Tp. 40 S., R. 9 W., W.M., in the county of Josephine

5. The Ditch to be 2 miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, Tp. 40 S., R. 9 W., W.M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.80 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Rough & Ready Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/50th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 3, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 28, 1939 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1940 Extended to Oct. 1, 1941 Extended to Oct. 1, 1942

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1941 Extended to Oct. 1, 1942
