

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT CERTIFICATE NO. 14449

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, E. F. Herr (Name of applicant) of Forest Grove (Post office), County of Washington, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Carpenter Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2/100 cubic feet per second. domestic and live stock (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Supplies (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 42 ft. North and 10 ft. West from the 1/8 corner of East line of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 9, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., Will. Mer. or said point of diversion is located 1178 ft. S. & 10 ft. W. of the NE Corner of Section 9, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., being within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Washington

5. The pipe line to be 952 in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and stock, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 4, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1941
