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*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 26367

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. G. and Bessie P. St. Marie (Name of applicant) of Canyon City (Post office), County of Grant, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Cherry Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Canyon Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.011 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 990 ft. North and 1750 ft. West from the corner of SE Corner, Sec. 11, T. 14 S., R. 31 E. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 11, Tp. 14 S., R. 31 E., W. M., in the county of Grant (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 700 ft. (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the E 1/2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 11, Tp. 14 S., R. 31 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Cherry Spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 12, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1941
