

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Frank West of Galice, County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Applegate Gulch, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.03 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1110 ft. South and 910 ft. East from the corner of Section 35, Township 34 South, Range 8 West, W. M.,

being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 34 S., R. 8 W., W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The Pipe to be 1 mile in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 (Lot 10) of Sec. 36, Tp. 34 S., R. 8 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate Gulch

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 6, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1941
