*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, United States of America, (Farm Security Administration) of 225 Terminal Sales Building, Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation 0-0-0-0-0

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Yamhill River, a tributary of Willamette

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Sufficient water to irrigate Thirty (30) acres

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.

4. The point of diversion is located at any place where applicant's land touches the Yamhill River, in the (NW 1/4 and SW 1/4) of NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 4 S., Range 4 W.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Yamhill River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 6, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 7, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941 Extended to Oct. 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942 Extended to Oct. 1, 1943
