

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 13762

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Glasgow Water Association, of North Bend, Coos County, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is An Unnamed Creek, a tributary of Coos Bay

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.8 cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Supply

4. The point of diversion is located 765 ft. South and 1730 ft. East from the NW corner of Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Tp. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M.,

being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 2, Tp. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M., in the county of Coos

5. The Main Pipe Line to be 1000 in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 2, Tp. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam 9 feet, length on top 34 feet, length at bottom 13 feet; material to be used and character of construction Timber crib with waste way through dam in wooden flume, storm overflow over top of dam.

\*\* Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.8 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from An Unnamed Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 25, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 7, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942
