

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, C. F. Stephens (Name of applicant) of Route 2, Dayton (Post office), County of Yamhill, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a tributary of Palmer Creek with no name and Palmer Creek, a tributary of Yamhill River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.5 c.f.s. from tributary and 1.5 c.f.s. per sec. from Palmer Creek. (Not for continuous irrigating) cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

(See Remarks) Unnamed tributary diversion is 250 ft. W. of NW Cor. of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec. 19

4. The point of diversion is located 160 ft. West and ft. from the NW Cor. corner of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4, Sec. 20. This is 380' E. of road. Water will be taken from 2 different places as shown above.

being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Yamhill

5. The Main Pipe to be 1020 ft. main 620 ft. laterals in length, terminating in the of Sec. , Tp. , R. , W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS— Tributary to Palmer Creek

6. (a) Height of dam 4 feet, length on top 40 feet, length at bottom 10 feet; material to be used and character of construction Log crib with earth fill, side diversion sodded spillway and also 8" pipe in bottom of dam to let out water.

(b) Description of headgate No headgate. Water is pumped.

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 4" Demming Centrifugal pump.

Power from "22" Caterpillar tractor. Total head approximately 100' 25 ft. Static Head

I have already filed on Palmer Creek but wish to obtain an additional 1.5 c.f.s. from Palmer Creek besides the 1.5 c.f.s. from the tributary. The same equipment will be used on all projects.

\* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

\*\* Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Palmer Creek and an Unnamed Tributary of Palmer Creek, being 0.25 c.f.s. from each source

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 7, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942
