

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, James Ivan Stewart (Name of applicant) of 475 Madrona Avenue, Salem (Post office), County of Marion, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-728 and Unnamed Spring, tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.39 cubic feet per second, being 0.38 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation and Domestic

4. The point of diversion is located 1100 ft. North and 1900 ft. East from the SW corner of Section 35,

being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 6 S., R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Polk

5. The Main Ditch to be 1000 ft. in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 6 S., R. 4 W., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Reservoir to be constructed under Permit No. R-728 and an unnamed spring.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation and Domestic, being 0.38 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 28, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 15, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1941 Extended to Oct. 1, 1946 Extended to Oct. 1, 1947 Extended to Oct. 1, 1950 Extended to Oct. 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942 Extended to Oct. 1, 1944 Extended to Oct. 1, 1950
