

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. B. Foster (Name of applicant) of Willamina Rural Route (Post office), County of Polk State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed stream (Name of stream), a tributary of South Yamhill River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.10 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic in house and mill and families employed by mill (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 100 ft. S and 900 ft. W from the SE corner of Section 15 (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

5. The Pipe line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 1600 ft. and 1000 ft. (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 6 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Unnamed Stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic and Mill

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 19, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 15, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942
