\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. A. Elliott, Acting Forest Supervisor, Willamette Natl. Forest of Eugene, County of Lane, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Stream, a tributary of North Santiam River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.03 cubic feet per second.

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic use

4. The point of diversion is located 669 ft. East and 231 ft. South from the NW corner of Section 22, T. 11 S., R. 7 E., W. M.,

being within the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 22, Tp. 11 South, R. 7 East, W. M., in the county of Linn

5. The Pipeline to be 1865 feet in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 11 South, R. 7 East, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Unnamed Stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 24, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 15, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942
