*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ada Weston (Name of applicant) of R.D. #2, Box 142, Grants Pass (Post office), County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Dutcher Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.38 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1550 ft. South and 1600 ft. East from the N1/4 corner of Section 15, T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the SE1/4 NE1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M., in the county of Josephine (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The flume and ditch to be 800 feet (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NE1/4 NE1/4 & SE1/4 NE1/4 & SW1/4 NE1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam none feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Lumber. One opening 6" x 8" (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 3" centrifugal pump (Size and type of pump) 2 H.P. gas engine. 8 ft. lift. (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

** Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Dutcher Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 12, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942
