*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mrs. Annie Reinoehl of Hood River, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Waste water from SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 2 N. R. 10 E., a tributary of Hood River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.05 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Supplemental Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 763 ft. S and 340 ft. W from the corner of SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 10 - T. 2 N. R. 10 E. W. M.

being within the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 2 N. R. 10 E., W. M., in the county of Hood River

5. The pipe line to be 400 ft. in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 2 N. R. 10 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: and SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS.

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 measured at the point of diversion from the stream cubic feet per second/or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from waste water from SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 10, T. 2 N., R. 10 E., being 0.5 c.f.s. from each point of diversion.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
