## DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam 4 feet, length on top 12-16 feet, length at bottom  
3 feet; material to be used and character of construction concrete  
 (Loose rock, concrete, masonry,  
 rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate  
 (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description

 (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

**PERMIT**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Unnamed Stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is Fish ponds, domestic and irrigation, being  
0.75 c.f.s. for fish ponds; 0.21 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per  
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a  
diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the  
irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.  
The priority date of this permit is October 5, 1939, being identical with the priority of  
Permit No. 14092, in the name of the Coast Property  
Corporation in accordance with agreement of July 11, 1939.  
Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1941 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1941
