PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Unnamed Stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation and Domestic, being 0.38 c.f.s.
for irrigation and 0.62 c.f.s. for domestic.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a
diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the
irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
October 5, 1939, being identical with the priority of
The priority date of this permit is Permit No. 14086, in the name of Sadie Minton, in ac-
cordance with agreement of July 11, 1939.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1941 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
October 1, 1941 Extended to Oct. 1, 1943

October 1, 1942 Extended to Oct. 1, 1943
