CERTIFICATE NO. 14672

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. M. Flood (Name of applicant) of Gold Beach (Post office), County of Curry, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Purposes (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 2149 ft. South and 890 ft. West from the NE corner of Section 29, Township 36 South, Range 14 West, (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 36 South, R. 14 West, W. M., in the county of Curry (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The Pipe Line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 1190 ft. (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the Lot 6 and SE 1/4, NE 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 36 South, R. 14 West, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam 3 feet, length on top 12 feet, length at bottom 10 feet; material to be used and character of construction Concrete dam (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, with wasteway over top rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate 3- 3/4" pipe intake (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

*A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

**Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 6, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 20, 1941 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1942

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1943
