

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT CERTIFICATE NO. 15423

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, F. D. Coon (Name of applicant) of Dillard (Post office), County of Douglas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Umpqua River (Name of stream), a tributary of Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Two cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and ft. from the corner of on left river bank between a point which is S. 70° 30' W. 3105 ft. and a point which is N. 67° 35' W. 2564 ft. from the 1/4 cor. between Secs. 35, T. 28 S., R. 6 W.; and Sec. 2, T. 29 S., R. 6 W., Willamette Meridian.

5. The Pipe Line to be 1300 ft. in length, terminating in the indeterminate locn. of Sec. of Tp. R. W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.57 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 11, 1940

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 30, 1941 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1942 Extended to Oct. 1, 1944

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1943 Extended to Oct. 1, 1944
