

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT CERTIFICATE NO. 14016

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Herman Hongell (Name of applicant) of Bullards (Post office), County of Coos, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed branch (Name of stream), a tributary of Coquille River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3/100 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Unnamed Branch

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 10, 1940

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 30, 1941 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1942
