This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.4 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

John Day River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Supplemental Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to September 30th of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 15, 1940

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 21, 1941 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1942 Extended to Oct. 1, 1944

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1943 Extended to Oct. 1, 1944
