CERTIFICATE NO. 15448

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, S.R. Smith (Name of applicant) of Box 615A, Rt. #12, Milwaukie (Post office), County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Kellogg Creek & Unnamed Spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.06, being 0.04 c.f.s. from creek for irrig., 0.01 c.f.s. from creek for pond, and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring for domestic. cubic feet per second.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Kellogg Creek and Unnamed Spring, being 0.05 c.f.s. from Kellogg Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. from Unnamed Spring.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation, Domestic, and Pond, being 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation from Kellogg Creek, 0.01 c.f.s. for Pond from Kellogg Creek, and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic from Unnamed Spring.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 7, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 12, 1942 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944
