

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Forrest A. Klum (Name of applicant) of Scappoose (Postoffice), County of Columbia, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Scappoose Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Scappoose Bay

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.12 cubic feet per second. one source (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. N. and ft. E. from the corner of One diversion point will be North 135 feet from the NW Corner of the Jesse Miles D.L.C. and one N. 70° W. 300 feet from the said NW corner of said D.L.C., all being in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 12, T. 3 N., R. 2 W., W. M., being within the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, Tp. 3 N., R. 2 W. of W. M., in the county of Columbia

5. The pipe to be 300 feet in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, Tp. 3 N., R. 2 W. of W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam none feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

South Scappoose Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 11, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 12, 1942 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944
