Known as Tract #22 Unrecorded, of the Subdivision of the John F. Risley Tracts, situated in Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Willamette Meridian, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, and being a part of the Jacob S. Risley Donation Land Claim #51, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe driven in the ground at a point which is S. $66^{\circ}33'$ W. 1228.19 feet and N. $23^{\circ}27'$ W. 300.00 feet from an iron pipe driven in the ground in the center of the River County Road, where the same intersects the southeast boundary of the said Jacob S. Risley D.L.C.; thence S. $66^{\circ}33'$ W. parallel with the southeast boundary of said claim 319.80 feet; to a point in the meander line of the right bank of the Willamette River; thence tracing the meander line of the right bank of the Willamette River, down stream N. $18^{\circ}41'$ W. 100.35 feet; thence N. $66^{\circ}33'$ E. 311.64 feet; to an iron pipe driven in the ground; thence S. $23^{\circ}27'$ E. 100.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.725 acres, more or less.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0125 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Willamette River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/30th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 21, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 12, 1942 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944
