

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT CERTIFICATE NO. 14531

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Clayton Knodell (Name of applicant) of Enterprise (Post office), County of Wallowa, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Wallowa River (Name of stream), a tributary of Grande Ronde River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.23 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 700 ft. South and 2558 ft. East from the W 1/4 corner of Section 30, (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

5. The Emmons & Fitzpatrick Ditch (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 1 1/2 miles (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 25, Tp. 1 S., R. 43 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 2 feet, length on top 18 feet, length at bottom 18 feet; material to be used and character of construction Loose rock and brush wing dam. Same dam as used by the Emmons-Fitzpatrick Ditch

(b) Description of headgate Lumber. Same headgate as used by the Emmons Fitzpatrick Ditch. One opening, size 3' x 2'.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Wallowa River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second a diversion of not to exceed 1 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30-day period from May 1, to July 31, and thereafter shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the remainder of the irrigation season ending October 1, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 16, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 21, 1942 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944
