* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Frank D. Cohan (Name of applicant) of 720 S. W. Ankeny St., Portland (Post office), County of Oregon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tualatin River and an unnamed stream (Name of stream) and spring, a tributary of Tualatin River

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.36 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the

stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Tualatin River, Unnamed Stream and Spring, being 0.275 c.f.s. from Tualatin River, 0.075 c.f.s. from Unnamed Stream, and 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation, Supplemental Irrigation and Domestic, being 0.275 c.f.s. from Tualatin River, being 0.20 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.075 c.f.s. for Suppl. Irrigation; 0.075 c.f.s. from Unnamed Stream for irrigation, and 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring for domestic.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The supplemental supply from the Tualatin River is to be used only when there is an insufficient quantity in the unnamed stream to supply the 0.075 c.f.s.

The priority date of this permit is June 25, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1942 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before
