* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, C. B. Buchanan (Name of applicant) of 248 Walnut St., Hillsboro (Post office), County of Washington, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tualatin River (Name of stream), a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is One (1) cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 300 ft. North & 760 ft. West of Section 3, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., (Section or subdivision) corner of Section 3, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., 420 ft. and 1600 ft. from the SE corner of Section 3, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the #1, SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Washington (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The Pipe Line to be 2000 ft. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description Expect to use a centrifugal pump with 3 inch outlet to be driven by tractor or 15 HP electric motor. Total lift of water approximately 60 ft. (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

** Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydro-electric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Tualatin River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 20, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1942 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944
