To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, The War Department, United States of America, c/o Constructing Quartermaster

of 15th and Park Terrace, Albany, County of Linn, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Willamette River (Name of stream), a tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 10 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is For use by the Federal Government in connection with maintenance & operation of the proposed military development near Corvallis.

4. The point of diversion is located 791 ft. North and 2656 ft. East from the SW corner of Section 3, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Bearing from point of diversion to S. W. Corner of Section 3, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M. S. 73° 25' W., 2771 ft. distant

being within the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Benton

5. The Main Pipe Line to be 21,423 ft. in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 20, Tp. 10 S., R. 4 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction

(b) Description of intake headgate Concrete wet wall with four vertical shaft turbine pumps.

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description 1-3600 g.p.m., 1-2700 g.p.m., and 2-1800 g.p.m. low head turbine pumps, and a set of high head horizontal centrifugal pumps of same capacity operated by electric motors. Pump capacity in excess of the rate applied for is for standby use only.

** Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydro-electric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Willamette River

This water is to be applied to all those uses which are essential in the maintenance and operation of the proposed military development near Corvallis, on lands, the descriptions of which are to be determined at the time of making final proof, such descriptions to be made a part of the certificate of water right to be issued after the making of final proof.

The priority date of this permit is November 7, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 12, 1942 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944
