

**\* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT**

**To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon**

I, RAY F. KELLY (Name of applicant)

of The Dalles (Post office), County of Wasco

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Not incorporated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Five Mile Creek (Name of stream)

, a tributary of Eight Mile Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/10 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is stock and domestic purposes. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1320 ft. South and 675 ft. East from the NW corner of Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 12 E., W. M. (Section or subdivision)

5. The pipe line to be 500 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 17, Tp. 1 S.

R. 12 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

**Diversion Works—**

6. (a) Height of dam 8 feet, length on top 78 feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction reinforced concrete with concrete braces. (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate 6" pipe--valve gate (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description --- (Size and type of pump)

(Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

\* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

\*\* Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydro-electric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Five Mile Creek and Reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-19513, Permit No. R- 772 .

The use to which this water is to be applied is Stock and Domestic, being 0.09 c.f.s. for stock and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 29, 1941

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1943 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1943

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1944
