* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Badger Improvement District (Name of applicant) of Wamic (Post office), County of Wasco, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Oregon March 9, 1940

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Badger Lake reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-13087, Permit No. R-773 and the natural flow of Badger Creek, a tributary of White River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 24 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation, domestic and live stock

4. The point of diversion is located 650 ft. and 21 ft. from the corner of N. 65° 21' W. 1938.2 ft. from the East corner, Section 32, T. 3 S., R. 11 E., W. M.

being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 32, Tp. 3 South, R. 11 East, W. M., in the county of Wasco

5. The Main Ditch is to be 10 or more miles in length, terminating in the Main Ditch of Sec. 32, Tp. 3 South, R. 11 East, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 24.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the

stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Badger Lake Reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-13087, Permit No. R-773, and the natural flow of Badger Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Supplemental Irrigation, Domestic and Stock, being 23.86 c.f.s. for supplemental irrigation and 0.14 c.f.s. for domestic and stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed one acre foot per acre during any 30-day period up to July 1st of each year and not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; provided, that the rate of flow shall not exceed one-fortieth of a second-foot per acre up to July 1st of each year and thereafter not to exceed one-eightieth of a second-foot per acre, except in case of rotation; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 21, 1929

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1943 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1944 Extended to Oct. 1, 1949 Extended to Oct. 1, 1951 Extended to Oct. 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1945 Extended to Oct. 1, 1949 Extended to Oct. 1, 1951 Extended to Oct. 1, 1953
