

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, L. A. Sieg and Anna Pearl Sieg, husband and wife, of Baker, Baker County, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring Creek, tributary of Salmon Creek, a tributary of Powder River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one foot cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 75 ft. South from the NE corner of Northwest quarter (NW 1/4)

being within the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 8 S., R. 39 E., W. M., in the county of Baker

5. The main to be 7/8 of one mile in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 26, Tp. 8 S., R. 39 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam two feet, length on top four feet, length at bottom four feet; material to be used and character of construction Lumber

(b) Description of headgate Timber, one opening two feet wide, one foot deep;

Remarks: As shown by accompanying plat, the point of diversion as given in answer to Question 4 will divert water into an established ditch running North along west side of County Road through center of Sections 34 and 27 to intersection with another "Spring Creek" which is a tributary of Pine Creek; the water will be carried in the last mentioned stream to the SW corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27, at which point said stream crosses another County Road running East and West through the center of Sections 27 and 26, and at that point the water will be again diverted, by similar dam and headgate into another established ditch and conducted west along the north side of the second mentioned County Road to the Southwest corner of the forty acre tract to be irrigated.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Spring Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 2, 1942

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 10, 1943 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1944

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1945
