

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Benton Co. Flax Growers Co-op. (Name of applicant) of Junction City, Route 3, (Post office) County of Benton State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation February 5, 1942 Monroe, Oregon

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Long Tom River (Name of stream), a tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 100,000 gal. per day cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Manufacturing (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 900' ft. South and 450' ft. West from the NE corner of Section 16, T. 14 S., R. 5 W., (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 14 S., R. 5 W., W. M., in the county of Benton

5. The Pipe Line to be 525' in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 14 S., R. 5 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.155 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Long Tom River

The use to which this water is to be applied is for retting and processing flax.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 22, 1942

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 10, 1943 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1944

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1945
