

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jesse C. Plankinton (Name of applicant) of Waldport (Post office), County of Lincoln, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Three unnamed streams (Name of stream), a tributary of Little Creek, a tributary of Pacific Ocean.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.5 cubic feet per second, being 0.2 c.f.s. from West Stream, 0.2 from East Stream and 0.1 c.f.s. from North Stream. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic Use, including use in auto camp. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 200 North 300 East, 200 South 100 East, 200 South and 300 East from the NW corner of said Lot, * (Section or subdivision)

R. 12 W., W.M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Three Unnamed Streams, being 0.2 c.f.s. from West Stream, 0.2 c.f.s. from East Stream, and 0.1 c.f.s. from North Stream.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic use, including use in auto camp.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 18, 1942

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 10, 1943 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1944

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1945
