 State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
 following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

## Diversion Works—

6. (a) Height of dam 1 feet, length on top 2 feet, length at bottom  
2 feet; material to be used and character of construction earth  
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry,  
 rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Timber One opening 1' x 1'  
(Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)  
valve in 2" pipe.

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description  
(Size and type of pump)

(Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

\* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

\*\* Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydro-electric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Still Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation and Domestic, being 0.15 c.f.s.  
for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per  
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a  
diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the  
irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 17, 1942

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 10, 1943 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
October 1, 1944

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before  
October 1, 1945
