\* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Fred Svinth (Name of applicant) of Prospect, Box 66 (Post office), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mill Creek, North Fork Rogue (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.14 cubic feet per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. for domestic & 0.10 c.f.s. for swimming pool. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic and lawn for four families and swimming pool. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 153 ft. South and 32 ft. East from the N 1/4 corner of Section 32, (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

Diversion Works—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Mill Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic, including the irrigation of a lawn not exceeding 1/2 acre in area, and Swimming Pool, being 0.04 c.f.s. for domestic, and 0.10 c.f.s. for swimming pool.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 9, 1942

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 7, 1943 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1944

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1945
