* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Elma M. Monroe (Name of applicant) of La Grande, R. F. D., (Post office) County of Union State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a spring located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 33, Tp. 1 S., R. 38 E., W. M., a tributary of unknown (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/40th cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supply and stock use (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 220 ft. West and 360 ft. South from the NE corner of SE 1/4 of Section 33, Tp. 1 S., R. 38 E., W. M., (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 33, Tp. 1 S., R. 38 E., W. M., in the county of Union (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The main pipe line is 111 feet in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 33, Tp. 1 S., R. 38 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A Spring located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 33, Township 1 South, Range 38 East, W. M.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic, including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding 1/2 acre in area and Stock use, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 14, 1942

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 5, 1944 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1945

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1946
