

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Puget Timber Company of Oregon by W. T. Miller, Atty. of Grants Pass (U. S. Nat'l Bank Bldg), County of Josephine State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation March 1940 at Eugene, Lane County, Oregon

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is East Fork Illinois River, a tributary of Illinois River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.50 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Lumber Mill Log Pond, Boiler

4. The point of diversion is located 1600 ft. S and 1200 ft. E from the NW corner of section 27

being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 39 S R. 8 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The main ditch to be 5 miles in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 39 S R. 8 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from East Fork Illinois R.

The use to which this water is to be applied is lumber mill, log pond, and boiler.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 21, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 15, 1945 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1946

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1947
