* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Chas. E. and Minnie H. Reese (Name of applicant) of The Dalles (Post office), County of Wasco, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Mosier Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.134 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 300 ft. S and 1100 ft. E from the SW corner of Section 19, T. 2 N., R. 12 E., W. M. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the NW 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 2N, R. 12 E, W. M., in the county of Wasco

5. The ditch to be 1200 ft. in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 2N, R. 12 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.134 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Mosier Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/60th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from March 1, to October 1,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 28, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 15, 1945 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1946 Extended to Oct. 1, 1947 Extended to Oct. 1, 1948

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before
