To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, George W. Murison (Name of applicant) of Willard (Post office), County of Douglas, State of Ore, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Umpqua River (Name of stream), a tributary of The Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/100th (0.01) cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supply (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

5. The Pipe Line to be 300 ft. in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 29 S, R. 6 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic including 1/2 acre garden irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 21, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 11, 1945 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1946

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1947
