No. 58 Township 1 South Range 1 West, a point in Section 3 Township 1 South Range 1 West Willamette Meridian, in Washington County, Oregon; running thence (Magnetic Variation 22° 30' E.) South 1° 26' West 498.0 feet to the center of County Road No. 568; thence in center of said road South 61° 38' West 1381.9 feet to angle No. 1 in said road; thence North 83° 00' West 1409.5 feet to the line between Sections 3 and 4, said township and range; thence North 0° 30' West 967.0 feet along said Section line to an iron pipe on the South line of said Hall D.L. C.; thence North 89° 57' East 2622.7 feet to the place of beginning, containing 56.7 acres, more or less.
