

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Carl Barnard (Name of applicant)

of Route #2 Dallas (Post office), County of Polk

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Teal Creek and unnamed spring tributary (Name of stream), a tributary of Little Luckiamute River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.135 cubic feet per second. being 0.01 for domestic and 0.125 for irrigation (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.) being 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed spring tributary for domestic and 0.125 c.f.s. from Teal Creek for irrigation for irrigation, anywhere along Teal Cr. on property

4. The point of diversion is located approx. 200 ft. South end corner of 200 ft. West of the section corner common to Sec's 26, 27, 34 & 35 (Section of subdivision)

being within the NE 1/4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 8 S, R. 6 W, W. M., in the county of Polk (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.135 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Teal Creek and unnamed spring tributary

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation and domestic, being 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed spring tributary for domestic and 0.125 c.f.s. from Teal Creek for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 13, 1944

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 11, 1945 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1946

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1947
